#### **Bidding**

- 1. The placing of a bid will constitute acceptance of the conditions of sale.
- 2. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalog. The right is reserved to withdraw any lot or lots and to group two or more lots.
- 3. Lots are sold to the highest bidder at one advance over the second highest bid. The auctioneer shall regulate the bidding and in the event of any dispute the auctioneer's decision shall be final.
- 4. The auctioneer shall not be liable for errors and omissions in executing instructions to bid.
- 5. Unlimited bids and bids believed not to be made in good faith will be respectfully declined.
- 6. Minimum bid on any lot is \$50.00.
- 7. All lots will be sold at the price for which they are knocked down by the auctioneer, plus a commission of 15%.

#### **Payment of Purchases**

- 8. Successful bidders will be notified of lots purchased and must remit before lots are delivered. Persons who are known to us may, at our option, have purchases forwarded for immediate payment.
- 9. Terms are immediate payment in U.S. funds on receipt of the invoice. Payment by credit card will be subject to a 2% service charge.


