## Bidding

1. The placing of a bid will constitute acceptance of the conditions of sale.

3. Lots are sold to the highest bidder at one advance over the second highest bid. The auctioneer shall regulate the bidding and in the event of any dispute the auctioneer's decision shall be final.
4. The auctioneer shall not be liable for errors and omissions in executing instructions to bid.
5. Unlimited bids and bids believed not to be made in good faith will be respectfully declined.
6. Minimum bid on any lot is $\$ 50.00$.
7. All lots will be sold at the price for which they are knocked down by the auctioneer, plus a commission of $15 \%$.

## Payment of Purchases

8. Successful bidders will be notified of lots purchased and must remit before lots are delivered. Persons who are known to us may, at our option, have purchases forwarded for immediate payment.
9. Terms are immediate payment in U.S. funds on receipt of the invoice. Payment by credit card will be subject to a $2 \%$ service charge.
10. The mode of shipment shall be at our option unless we are given specific instructions. A minimum charge of $\$ 1.50$ will be made in addition to postage, insurance, and handling.

Highlights: 1883 with Cents AU cleaned, 1889 VF, 1892 VF, 1910 XF, 1911 XF. The keys are: 1885 AG, 1886 AG, \& 1912-S G. A far better set than that typically seen and worth inspection.

## Jefferson Nickels

24 (294) 1938 // 2018-S Proof in $2 \times 2 s$ in a dealer stockbook wide grade range but many are nice unc even among the earlies.
Accum Jeff nickels, incl (3) Littleton green coin albums 1976-2006 wellfilled w/ P-D-S; (4) Whitman folders, three from 1938 and one from 1962; a few loose coin album pages for more 1940s-70s coins; several circ, Unc and proof nickels in retail packaging, incl both 2005-S PR70 and 1979-D MS64; overall numerous proof coins \& (26) war nickels.

## Half Dimes

$26 \quad 1795$ Flowing Hair perhaps VG by wear but a small bend in the coin has caused the wear to be a bit uneven. The right edge of the coin appears to have been filed. Flaws of this kind are typical of small coins of the period. The present example is still original and attractive and represents an affordable example of this scarce early type.
271803 Large 8 Draped Bust AG. Imperfections consistent w/ very small coins of the period, this coin has details clear enough for identification, and an eye-catching bold date. Inspect!

## Bust Dimes

281807 Draped Bust G by wear w/ damage in the form of scratches and edge filing but still ok for type. Draped Bust dimes rarely come w/o some type of significant imperfection.
291809 AG. A few minor flaws but extensive wear is the only real issue. A scarce early dime w/ a mintage of just 44,700.
$30 \quad 1835$ VF perhaps better mottled grey toning.
31 (10) Diff Capped Bust Dimes 1811 // 1834 most AG/G+. A couple w/ impairments but a nice assortment overall incl 1811 over 09 (AG holed), plus 1823 over 22 AG. Small coins of this period usually have problems so the coins are still worth inspection.

## Seated Dimes

32 (24) Diff 1837 // 1853 Arrows in an LOC Vol 41 album for Early Dimes (Part 1) 1796 // 1853. Most are low-grade (AG/G+) originals a few w/ minor to more significant impairments. A fine assortment though, incl a couple better dates s/a 1845-O, 1847, 1849-O, 1851-O, \& 1852-O.
33 (44) Diff mostly common dates 1853-O Arrows // 1891-S in an LOC Vol 42 album Early Dimes Part 2. Coins largely AG to VG+ by wear but sev w/ nicks and other impairments. Inspection recommended.

38 Accum (320) Mercury dimes in (7) old Whitman folders (9014); taken from circulation by various collectors. (23.14 oz ASW)

## Roosevelt Dimes

39 (65) 1946 // 1964-D circ and unc in $2 \times 2 \mathrm{~s}$ in a binder (dealer stockbook). Many nice among them incl some proofs. Also incl are (8) clad issues making (73) total coins in the lot.
40 (48) in a complete set $1946 / / 1964-$ D all beautiful original BU coins in $2 \times 2$ s in binder pages. We occasionally hear about the "full torch" and "full bands" coins, but generally, the Roosevelt Dime series doesn't get much respect these days. Except for the proofs, the greysheet doesn't even list prices for them!

## Bust Quarters

411805 Draped Bust Browning-2 VG+ detail. Perfectly original and a decent grade but w/ a plugged hole obliterating the " 18 " of the date.

## Seated Quarters

42 1859-S near F detail but the coin has a plugged hole ( 2 mm ) right above Liberty's head. This is a super-scarce date however, so inspection may be warranted. The San Francisco quarters saw extensive use for decades after being minted making higher-grade survivors rare. In the 5th edition of Mega Red, expert Larry Briggs posits that many 1859-S quarters possess an "etching" on their surface (this coin has that etching), suggesting that they were "unearthed." No further details are provided.

## Barber Quarters

43 1896-S AG original. A full G obv w/ rev weaker but clear. Mintmark is faint but evident.

44 1901-S AG original. Wear obliterates most of the legend on the rev but the central details are clear. There was little interest in the issue at the time it was struck resulting in very low survival rates. Coupled with the fact that all Barber coins saw very heavy use, those 1901-S quarters that do remain are usually in very low grades. Even a G+ is a mid four-figure coin. It will be a long time before another is offered.
45 1913-S AG original. Wear consistent $\mathrm{w} /$ the grade but no other issues of any kind. At 40,000, the 1913-S quarter has the lowest mintage of any 20th Century coin issued for circulation.

46 (71) Diff in a nearly-complete set 1892 // 1916-D missing only the keys 1896-S, 1901-S, \& 1913-S. Housed in a Whit 9416 album, most grade AG to $G+$ and have their natural color. Among the semi-keys, 1896-O, 1897-S, 1901-O, 1905-O, 1908-S, 1909-O, \& 1914-S are all AG originals. The set is well worth inspection.

47 (28) Diff 1892-O // 1916-D loose AG to F but most are full-rim G originals.

## Standing Liberty Quarters

48 (35) Diff in a near-complete set 1917 // 1930-S missing only 1916 \& 1923-S. In a Whit 9417 album. As is typical of the series, the earlies show considerable detail but most have weak dates. The laters are typical G to F originals. Compared to other denominations of the same time period, Liberty Standing Quarter sets are rarely offered.

## Washington Quarters

49 1932-D NGC G4. Not that it makes much difference, but the coin deserves VG8.

50 1932-S AU Detail. The coin has been lightly cleaned and there are a couple of surface disturbances on the rev. Still attractive and would fit nice in high-grade set.

51 (81) in a virtually complete set 1932 // 1964-D missing only the scarce 1932 D \& S. Circ grades w/ a few Unc mixed in. In a Whit 9122 album that incl (38) clads sporadic from 1965 // 1988-D
52 (85) Diff 1932 // 1967 in a virtually complete set missing only 1932-S. In (5) Dansco folder pages, most earlies VG to perhaps XF (32-D is F dark), laters largely VF or better. A decent set!

## State Quarters

53 Accum of State Quarter sets; (3) metal lock boxes as sold by mass retailer, each $\mathrm{w} /(50)$ coins individually encapsulated (likely complete state collection of P coins), appear all UNC; additional Littleton green folder w/ all (56) states \& territories (mixed mint marks) most appear UNC; finally a dime store holder for the 50 states, taken from circ, likely all P coins; total FV \$64.
54 Unc sets re-packed by Cable Shopping Network, incl regular Unc coins for P and D, plus gold plated and platinum plated sets; years incl 19992005, two sets of the (4) styles (56 items total)

## Bust Halves

$56 \quad 1808 \mathrm{O}-103 \mathrm{VG}+$ nice original but there are old scratches on the coin however they blend nicely w/ it's natural color. In Overton's classic book on Bust Halves, author Donald Parsley notes that, "Most available specimens of 1808 are weakly struck [such that] with little wear they appear to be well worn."

571810 O-105 VF+ perhaps better. Beautiful original but light rev scratches around the eagle's head. Still very appealing.

581812 O-105a XF detail and original but w/ the beginnings of a drill hole on the eagle's neck.

591813 O-104 (R4) VG+ w/ great color but w/ a 1.5 mm hole above Liberty's head. O-104 is a scarce variety.
$60 \quad 1819$ O-108 F. A beautiful original but there is a very light 7 mm scratch near Liberty's shoulder.

611824 O-115 F+
621825 O-114 VF detail but holed ( 2.5 mm ) just left of the date. Though damaged, the coin remains of interest due to a strong double profile on Liberty.

631827 O-131 Fine. Natural light grey color.
641829 O-111a XF or very nearly so.
651831 O-102 XF+ lovely grey original.
$66 \quad 1835 \mathrm{O}-107 \mathrm{XF}+$ brightened at one time still very desirable.
671836 O-106 VF+ or better beautiful natural grey color.
68 1839-O Reeded Edge Fr-2 perhaps a bit better. Extensive wear is the only issue as there are no other defects or signs of abuse on this coin. From a mintage of only 116,000 the 1839 -O is quite scarce and is popularly collected today.

## Seated Halves

69 1855-S Arrows G detail w/ a solder blob in the center of the obv indicating that the coin may have been previously mounted. A lowmintage issue $(129,950) \mathrm{w} /$ a greysheet bid of $\$ 400$ in G 4 attesting to its scarcity.
70 1864-S VG. A beautiful original.
71 1866-S No Motto darker grey VG+ but there is some graffiti on the rev above the eagle's head. Still a nice coin overall especially for this scarce variety.
72 1872-CC Fr- 2. Extensive wear but easily discernable.
73 1878-CC G details - cleaned. Rims are bit weak in places but there is enough detail for the grade. A very scarce Seated Half w/ a mintage of only 62,000 . An opportunity for the specialist in this series as it may be quite some time before another comes along.
74 (19) Diff P-Mint and O-Mint coins 1843-O // 1861-O commons largely AG to VG w/ some impairments here and there. Housed in a Whit 9447 album.

75 (6) Diff S-Mint in a straight run 1858-S // 1863-S a couple G/G+ but most are VG originals.

96 1877-CC ANACS AU53 Details Plugged. Beautiful original color and detail but a small ( 2 mm ) plug is near Liberty's head @ K12. The plug blends perfectly with the overall color of the coin.
1877-S XF original in appearance but polished.
98 1878-S XF+ detail but brightened from a rather harsh cleaning.
