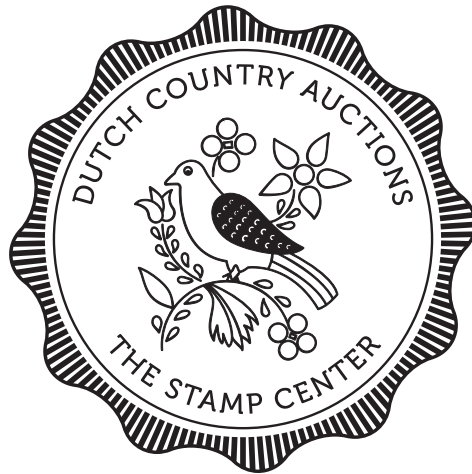

Bidding

1. The placing of a bid will constitute acceptance of the conditions of sale.
2. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalog. The right is reserved to withdraw any lot or lots and to group two or more lots.
3. Lots are sold to the highest bidder at one advance over the second highest bid. The auctioneer shall regulate the bidding and in the event of any dispute the auctioneer's decision shall be final.
4. The auctioneer shall not be liable for errors and omissions in executing instructions to bid.
5. Unlimited bids and bids believed not to be made in good faith will be respectfully declined.
6. Minimum bid on any lot is \$50.00.
7. All lots will be sold at the price for which they are knocked down by the auctioneer, plus a commission of 15%.

Payment of Purchases

8. Successful bidders will be notified of lots purchased and must remit before lots are delivered. Persons who are known to us may, at our option, have purchases forwarded for immediate payment.
9. Terms are immediate payment in U.S. funds on receipt of the invoice. Payment by credit card will be subject to a 2% service charge.
10. The mode of shipment shall be at our option unless we are given specific instructions. A minimum charge of \$1.50 will be made in addition to postage, insurance, and handling.
11. Successful bidders agree to pay for lots as specified above and no credit is extended. For overdue accounts a late charge of 5% per month (minimum \$30.00) will be charged. Accounts are considered overdue after (30) days.

Quality

12. Any lot, the description of which is incorrect, is returnable within ten (10) days of receipt and must be received within four weeks from the date of the auction. All disputed lots must be returned intact in the condition received. The following lots may not be returned without prior approval: lots from buyers who have had the opportunity to examine them before the sale; lots described as having defects or faults may not be returned because of faults; and, lots in which the buyer has bid more than double our estimate. No illustrated lot may be returned because of centering, margins, or other factors shown in the illustrations.

Authenticity

13. All lots are sold as genuine, but should any lot be proved otherwise by written opinion of any responsible authority acceptable to us, immediate refund of the full purchase price will be made, provided we are notified in writing within 14 days from date of sale that an opinion is being sought. If claim is not made within this period, no lots are returnable for any reason at any time. We will not be responsible for any charges incurred by the buyer for expertization fees and costs unless the opinion states the item is not genuine, in which case we will pay actual costs up to a maximum of \$100.00. In the event an item is proved "not as described" it is returnable for a full refund. Any lot which has a certificate dated within the last five years is sold in accordance with the certificate and is not returnable for any reason including an opinion obtained in a new certificate after the sale. While we occasionally suggest what grade a coin may receive if certified, we do guarantee that grade (or any other grade) if a coin is submitted for certification.

The distinctive obv die crack (which is mentioned on the NGC label) starts on the rim at K12 and extends downward to the bridge of Liberty's nose. This crack identifies the coin as having been struck by the Confederacy using the same obv die used to strike the famous half dollars with the CSA rev of which there are 5 known. Records show that 1,212,000 Seated Half Dollars were struck after the New Orleans Mint was taken over by the Confederacy on Mar 25th 1861; however, they are indistinguishable from those struck before Mar 25th 1861 by the federal government. But a small minority of the confederate issue were struck from the obv die having the diagnostic crack, thus providing the evidence for these coins to be of Confederate origin. It is a complete mystery why coins such as this end up with so much wear because the reeding around the coin's rim is more consistent with a grade of VF or even XF. The 1863 Seated Half is actually somewhat scarce and this issue deserves more respect than it gets. PCGS and NGC combined have graded only 272 in total, making it much less available than the common dates, but priced the same.	EST	60-80	SE
93	1871-CC VF+ w/ a few marks and a hairline patch over a repaired area at K6 on the rev. An extremely scarce Carson City issue. From a mintage of 153,950 Bowers estimates that only 375 to 450 remain extant today, mostly with extensive wear. Of a total of 317 graded by NGC and PCGS combined (many are re-submissions), 199 are in mint state as virtually the entire mintage was issued for collectors of the day or for foreign export.
